Travel along the circular Panorama Route, visiting the view sites of the Blyde River Canyon, home to the Three Rondavels and one of the natural wonders of Africa; gasp at the glory of God's Window, with a boundless view of mountains and fertile plains and visit Bourke's Luck Potholes. **[Included Meals: Breakfast]**

Depart after breakfast on a long drive today, travelling through eSwatini (Swaziland), visiting Ngwenya Glass, where a small group of eSwati craftsmen and women create beautifully handmade items from recycled glass. Our next stop is The Swazi Candles Centre where you will experience local artisans creating colourful, handmade candles. Our journey continues into the Kingdom of KwaZulu-Natal where ancient traditions and modern cultures of both Zulu and Settler have combined into a vibrant society living in peace and harmony. Arrive at your hotel in the late afternoon for overnight. **[Included Meals: Breakfast]**

**Distance travelled today: 375 kms**

---

**DAY 6 – FRIDAY**

**ST LUCIA AND SURROUNDS - DURBAN**

---

Guests have the option to take a morning optional open vehicle game drive in the Hluhluwe-iMfolozi Game Reserve (optional and for own account), before heading off to Durban. An orientation tour of Durban, that travels along the Golden Mile, the beachfront promenade, The Point Waterfront, and harbour introduces us to this multicultural, vibrant seaside city. The orientation tour concludes with a visit to the Durban Botanic Gardens before arriving at our hotel late afternoon. **[Included Meals: Breakfast]**

**DURBAN - DRAKENSBERG**

After breakfast, head into the majestic Southern Drakensberg Mountains. We visit the impressive 300-foot-high Howick Falls, located in the KwaZulu-Natal Midlands town of Howick. Our journey continues through the Southern Midlands Meander Route, arriving at our hotel, situated on a scenic World Heritage site, mid-afternoon. Your afternoon is at leisure to soak up the surroundings, or enjoy fishing, hiking and even horse riding in clean mountain air (all activities are optional and for own account). Sit down to a sumptuous dinner at your hotel. **[Included Meals: Breakfast & Dinner]**

**Distance travelled today: 280 kms**

**DAY 8 – SUNDAY**

**DRakensberg**

Enjoy a full day at leisure to soak up the surroundings of the magnificent Southern Drakensberg Mountains. There are also many leisure activities to be enjoyed at the Resort. Consider joining a thrilling 4x4 tour up the spectacular Sani Pass into the mountain Kingdom of Lesotho (optional and for own account). Enjoy an evening dinner at your hotel with a wide variety of local specialities to choose from. **[Included Meals: Breakfast & Dinner]**

**DAY 9 – MONDAY**

**DRakensberg – EASTERN CAPE COAST**

Depart after breakfast, on a long drive to the Eastern Cape entering the fourth of the provinces and the birthplace of Nelson Mandela (fondly known as Madiba). En route we see the old traditional way of life in the former homeland area known as the Transkei and stop for lunch (own account) outside the capital of Mthata. We travel past Nelson Mandela's birthplace and house, arriving late afternoon at our accommodation in Chinsta East, on the beautiful, unspoilt Eastern Cape Coast. A delicious dinner with local delicacies awaits you at your lodge. **[Included Meals: Breakfast & Dinner]**

**Distance travelled today: 520 kms**

---

**DAY 10 – TUESDAY**

**EASTERN CAPE COAST – TSITSIKAMMA**

We awake to the sounds of the crashing waves. The beach stretches on uninterrupted for many kilometres and the thick indigenous beach forest is a haven for an amazing variety of birdlife. We set off on a long drive today, heading to the Tsitsikamma Forest. **[Included Meals: Breakfast]**

**Distance travelled today: 510 kms**

**DAY 11 – WEDNESDAY**

**TSITSIKAMMA - KNYSNA**

After breakfast, visit the spectacularly beautiful Tsitsikamma Forest, which provides scenic walking opportunities. A short walk to the Storms River Mouth offers some magnificent views of the gorge and river below. Arrive in Knysna, known as the oyster box of South Africa, for check in at your hotel. Enjoy a dinner filled with culinary delights at the hotel's trendy restaurant. **[Included Meals: Breakfast & Dinner]**

**Distance travelled today: 92 kms**

---

**DAY 12 – THURSDAY**

**KNYSNA – OUDTSHOORN**

After breakfast, we travel inland over the spectacular Outeniqua Pass to Oudtshoorn, known as the 'feather capital of the world' because of its ostrich industry. We visit a working ostrich farm and then explore the famous Cango Caves, with a walk around its magnificent dripstone formations of stalactites and stalagmites. Overnight in Oudtshoorn. **[Included Meals: Breakfast]**

**Distance travelled today: 180 kms**

**DAY 13 – FRIDAY**

**OUDTSHOORN – CAPE TOWN**

Today is a long journey travelling along the famous Route 62 and through the Little Karoo, ending in Cape Town. On the way we stop off to sample top quality port style wines in Calitzdorp, before continuing via Worcester and the Huguenot Tunnel, arriving in Cape Town in the late afternoon. **[Included Meals: Breakfast]**

**Distance travelled today: 420 kms**

**DAY 14 – SATURDAY**

**CAPE TOWN (UNESCORTED)**

Enjoy a full day at leisure. ## **1 UNDERTAKING**

Cullinan Guided Journeys undertake to provide all services offered subject to the terms and conditions set out herein, which terms and conditions are accepted by the guest.

## **2 DEFINITION**

Cullinan Guided Journeys mean Cullinan Holdings LTD T/A Cullinan Guided Journeys

Guests mean: Individuals, groups, companies, or other legal persons using the services offered by Cullinan Guided Journeys and includes the agents of guests.

Services mean: The provision of accommodations and/or transportation and/or meals as offered by Cullinan Guided Journeys and accepted by the guest.

## **3 TERMS OF PAYMENT**

**3.1** Full payment of the quoted tour price is required 45 days before commencement of services (N.B: For tours that include Blue Train and/or Private Game Reserves and Lodges, a different schedule of deposits, payments and cancellation fees apply. This will be provided when applicable.)

### **Notes**

- i) Bookings made within 45 days of commencement of services must be accompanied by full payment of the tour plus rooming list.
- ii) Where circumstances do not permit the timeous receipt of funds, explicit confirmation of transfer of funds will enable us to reserve services.

**3.2** If payments are made in negotiable foreign currency, the payer will be responsible for any short payment resulting from exchange rate fluctuations. The exchange rate applied by the official bankers of Cullinan Guided Journeys on receipt of moneys will be accepted as the applicable rate.

**3.3** If the required final payment is not received by due date, Cullinan Guided Journeys reserve the right to withdraw services.

**3.4** Prices are subject to alteration without prior notice. Prices are subject to adjustment in the event of changes in government-imposed taxes, fuel price, airfares, hotel charges. Tourism levies and the introduction of national, regional, or local taxes or levies of whatever nature.

**3.5** All prices are quoted in ZA Rand or U.S.\$ unless otherwise explicitly agreed. Payment in the approved foreign currency will be accepted at the rate of exchange applied by the bankers of Cullinan Guided Journeys at the time of receipt of payment. Any shortfall resulting from exchange rate fluctuations will be for the account of the guest.

## **4 CANCELLATIONS**

### **4.1 General Conditions**

**4.1.1** Cancellations made more than 45 days prior to arrival will not normally result in cancellation fees being charged. However;

**4.1.2** Cullinan Guided Journeys reserve the right to recover any costs incurred or charges received from suppliers up to the date of cancellation.

**4.1.3** In the event of services being cancelled 45 days or less, prior to arrival, the following cancellation fees will apply.

- 45 days to 36 days before commencement of services: 25% total quoted tour price due.  
(Subject to 2. above)
- 35 days to 16 days before commencement of services: 50% of total quoted tour price due.  
(Subject to 2. above)
- 15 days or less before commencement of services: 100% of the total quoted tour price due

#### **4.2 Special Conditions**

Cullinan Guided journeys shall not be responsible for any damages whatsoever arising from any such alterations or cancellation.

**20 STANDARD AND SAFETY**

**20.1** Vehicles provided are large enough to accommodate the number of guests and luggage as is specified in Clause 13

**20.2** All drivers are licensed in terms of local legislation

**20.3** All vehicles are safe and comply with relevant safety regulations

**21 PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION ACT (“POPI”)**

**21.1 “Operator”** means an operator as defined in the Protection of Personal Information Act, 4 of 2013;

**21.2 “Personal Information”** means personal information as defined in the Protection of Personal Information Act, 4 of 2013;

**21.3 Protection of Personal Information**

2. All third parties who may assist us in supplying the services.

We undertake not to disclose your personal information unless it is legally or contractually required to do so.

We agree to use all reasonable efforts to ensure your personal information in our possession is kept confidential, stored in a secure manner and processed in terms of POPI.

You hereby acknowledge and warrant that:

1. Cullinan Guided Journeys is entitled to process and store any such Personal Information in the manner set out in Cullinan Guided Journeys' Privacy Policy, available on the website [www.cullinanguidedjourneys.com](http://www.cullinanguidedjourneys.com);
2. Cullinan Guided Journeys is entitled and authorised by you to transfer any Personal Information to any of its Operators; and
3. Cullinan Guided Journeys is entitled to store and back-up your Personal Information on its servers.

You confirm that you have read and agree to Cullinan Guided Journeys' Privacy Policy and hereby provide your consent to Cullinan Guided Journeys to process your personal information and acknowledge that you understand the purpose for which it is required and for which it will be used.

## **22 LAW**
